Charlton House, part of Royal Greenwich Heritage Trust, is a unique example of Jacobean architecture, the only manor house of its kind in London. Built between 1607 and 1612, it remained a private home until 1925, when it became a public museum. With a rich and colourful history, Charlton House boasts striking architecture and beautiful interiors, including original ceilings and fireplaces.

Today the house serves a variety of uses. As a community centre it is the meeting place for a diverse range of local special interest groups, who always welcome new members. See inside for further details. The house is also available as a unique wedding and party venue, providing a stunning backdrop for civil marriage ceremonies, drinks parties and receptions. The many spacious rooms and halls are the perfect location for meetings, conferences and training courses. Our food and drinks menu offers delicious homemade refreshments, freshly prepared in our kitchens each day. We are happy to develop menus to suit all tastes and occasions.
